The Survivor Hub is a survivor-led, non-profit initiative founded on Gadigal Land in Sydney. We support people who have been impacted by sexual assault throughout Australia.

We facilitate safe and inclusive **peer support groups ('MeetUps')** where survivors can connect with each other to ask questions, express concerns, vent, learn and heal.

MEETUPS

MeetUps are safe spaces for survivors to **connect, share** and **support** one another through their lived experiences. It is a place to find community with others who understand first-hand what they're going through.

MeetUps exist to assure survivors that they aren't alone and offer a sense of community through the highs and lows of their healing journeys.

Who can come to MeetUps?

MeetUps are open to all survivors aged 16 or older. They are also free to attend!
